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# DISCUSSION GUIDE

What exactly does it mean to not take the Lord's name in vain? In the Old Testament, God's personal name was Yahweh. It was so sacred that most Jews wouldn't even say it out loud. In today's culture, people use God's name in flippant ways without thinking twice about it. But God has called us to use his name to bring glory and honor to him.

#### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- In the past, what has this commandment meant to you? Was it one you
  were more likely to skip over or was it one you always followed? How
  has your perspective changed?
- When you hear someone use the Lord's name in vain, are you indifferent toward it or is it something that has always bothered you? Why?
- 3. Jason talked about three concrete ways that we use God's name in vain: by using it as a swear word, when we use it flippantly, and when we don't call upon the name of the Lord. Which one of these do you struggle with the most? Share this with someone and ask them to hold you accountable.
- 4. Read Acts 4:12, Romans 10:13, Proverbs 18:10, and John 14:14. What circumstances in your life right now should you be calling out to God for help instead of talking with someone else?

### **CHALLANGE**

Commit to not using God's name in vain anymore. Instead, think of ways that you can call upon the name of the Lord. He is waiting for us with open arms.
