DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Read 2 Kings 4:1-7. Have you ever felt you had nothing left to offer? How can this story encourage you when you feel that way?
- 2. In his message, Pastor Bob said, "The biggest mistake people make financially is they hold onto their flask of oil and miss God's multiplied blessing." Do you struggle in holding onto your flask of oil? If so, what makes it so hard to let go? If not, how have you seen freedom in giving up your flask of oil?
- 3. Read Leviticus 27:30 and Malachi 3:10. When people think of tithing, it's easy to think of it as giving to charities, shopping at the church bookstore, and volunteering your time. What do these verses teach us about tithing?
- 4. Read Psalm 24:1. Everything we have comes from God, was given by God, and belongs to God. How does that resonate with you? What changes can you start to make in your own life to trust God in this area?
